Description: *Racial Inequality is associated with negative mental health consequences for both Black youth genders, male and female. However, Black male youth differ in regard to long-term effects of psychological symptoms. Black male youth are more susceptible to the mental health effects of racial inequality over time such as Depression, PTSD, Anger Issues, Aggression, Risk Behaviors and more.*
